Gospel: Matthew 7:1-14, 24-29
The Holy Gospel according to Matthew,
the 7th chapter.
Glory to you, O Lord.

“Do not judge, so that you may not be
judged. ² For with the judgement you make
you will be judged, and the measure you
give will be the measure you get. ³ Why do
you see the speck in your neighbor’s eye,
but do not notice the log in your own
eye? ⁴ Or how can you say to your
neighbor, “Let me take the speck out of
your eye”, while the log is in your own
eye? ⁵ You hypocrite, first take the log out
of your own eye, and then you will see
clearly to take the speck out of your
neighbor’s eye.

⁶ Do not give what is holy to dogs; and do
not throw your pearls before swine, or they
will trample them under foot and turn and
maul you. ⁷ Ask, and it will be given to
you; search, and you will find; knock, and
the door will be opened for you. ⁸ For
everyone who asks receives, and everyone
who searches finds, and for everyone who
knocks, the door will be opened. ⁹ Is there
anyone among you who, if your child asks
for bread, will give a stone? ¹⁰ Or if the
child asks for a fish, will give a snake? ¹¹ If
you then, who are evil, know how to give
good gifts to your children, how much
more will your Father in heaven give good
things to those who ask him!

¹² In everything do to others as you would
have them do to you; for this is the law and
the prophets. ¹³ Enter through the narrow
gate; for the gate is wide and the road is
easy that leads to destruction, and there are
many who take it. ¹⁴ For the gate is narrow,
and the road is hard that leads to life, and
there are few who find it...

²⁴ Everyone then who hears these words
